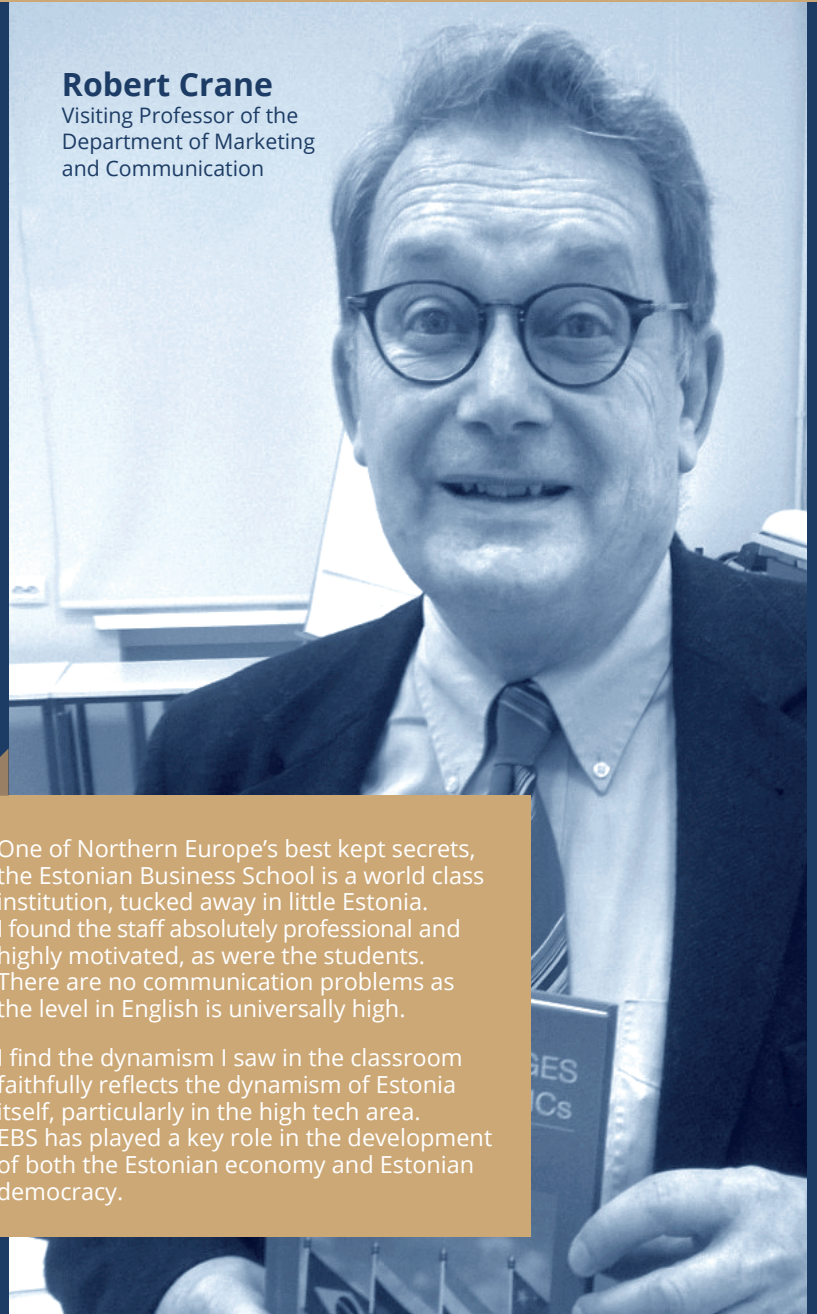

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Admission to EBS Master's studies takes place twice a year - in summer and in winter (only EU). Admitted students can start their studies either in September or in February (only EU). Application documents will be processed only after application fee is received.
