^{*}Other School Activities apply to the tuition cost for College Program or Stand Alone ESL.

^{*}Students must maintain 3.0 GPA or a grade S for ESL in order to receive scholarship for the following semester.

⁻If a cumulative or a previous semester GPA is **4.0**, the scholarship for appropriate semester will be up to **50%** of the semester tuition.

⁻If a cumulative or a previous semester GPA is between **3.0 and 3.99**, the scholarship for appropriate semester will be up to **45%** of the semester tuition.

^{*}Language Training level D tuition is **2,940** per semester without Scholarship.

^{*}Students must sign the "F-1 Student Program Policies" before he/she registers to ASA College.

^{*}All International Students must take a minimum of 12 credits per semester and maintain an 80% Attendance.

^{*}Students who want to take **Leave of Absence** must complete 2 consecutives semesters in order to qualify for Leave of absence.

^{*}Tuition and fees are subject to change without notice at the discretion of the college.
