

# Welcome to Vaala The Municipality of Oulujärvi






Vaala is located in Pohjois-Pohjanmaa Province







# Hydroelectric power plants Jylhämä and Nuojua







#### LAKE OULUJÄRVI – THE SEA OF KAINUU






#### **MANAMANSALO**

- Manamansalo is an island in the middle of Lake Oulujärvi
- Divides Lake Oulujärvi into two halves – Ärjänselkä and Niskanselkä
- 5th largest island in Finland, 76 km<sup>2</sup>
- Population ca.150
- 350 summer cottages














#### **Gneiss-rock**

The oldest gneiss rocks in the Lake Oulujärvi were created 2.600 to 2.700 million years ago



#### ROKUA NATIONAL PARK

- Established in 1956
- Area 8,8 km<sup>2</sup>
- Protects the natural lichen heathlands and unusual geological features of Rokua
- The landscape was formed during the latest ice age
   10.000 years ago





#### **GEOPARK ROKUA**

- Rokua Geopark consists of three different land areas: the Oulujoki River Valley, Lake Oulujärvi and the ridge and dune area of Rokua.
- Geopark-area forms a geological passage following esker ridges from the Muhos formation following Oulujoki River all the way to Lake Oulujärvi and Manamansalo island.
- Geopark combines the geological, natural and cultural history
   from ice age to present
