● Basic introduction to the municipality

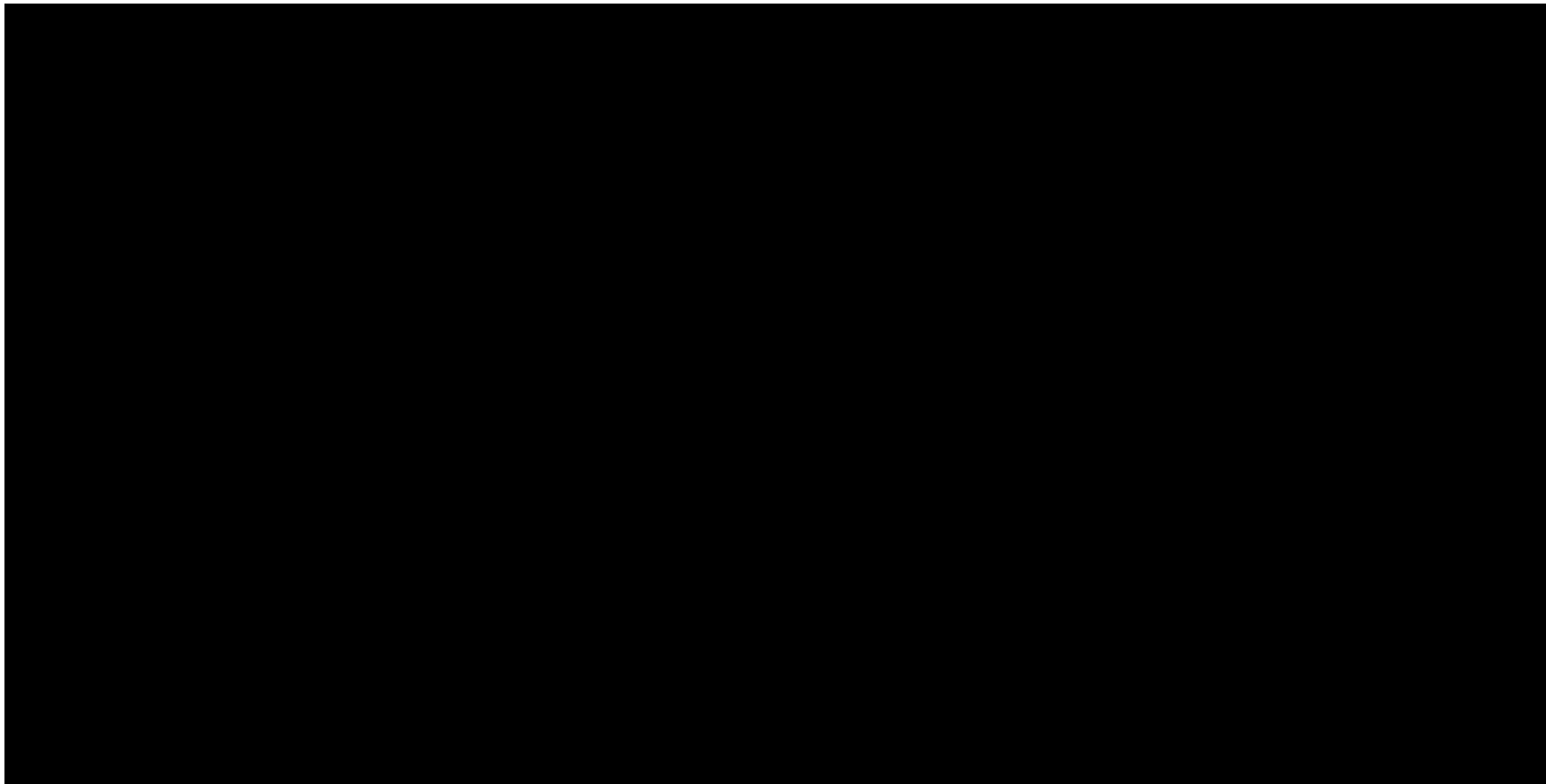
- The municipality of Joroinen is located in the northern Savo region and it is mostly countryside, forests, lakes and fields. The municipality has a population of about 4,700 people.

● High school

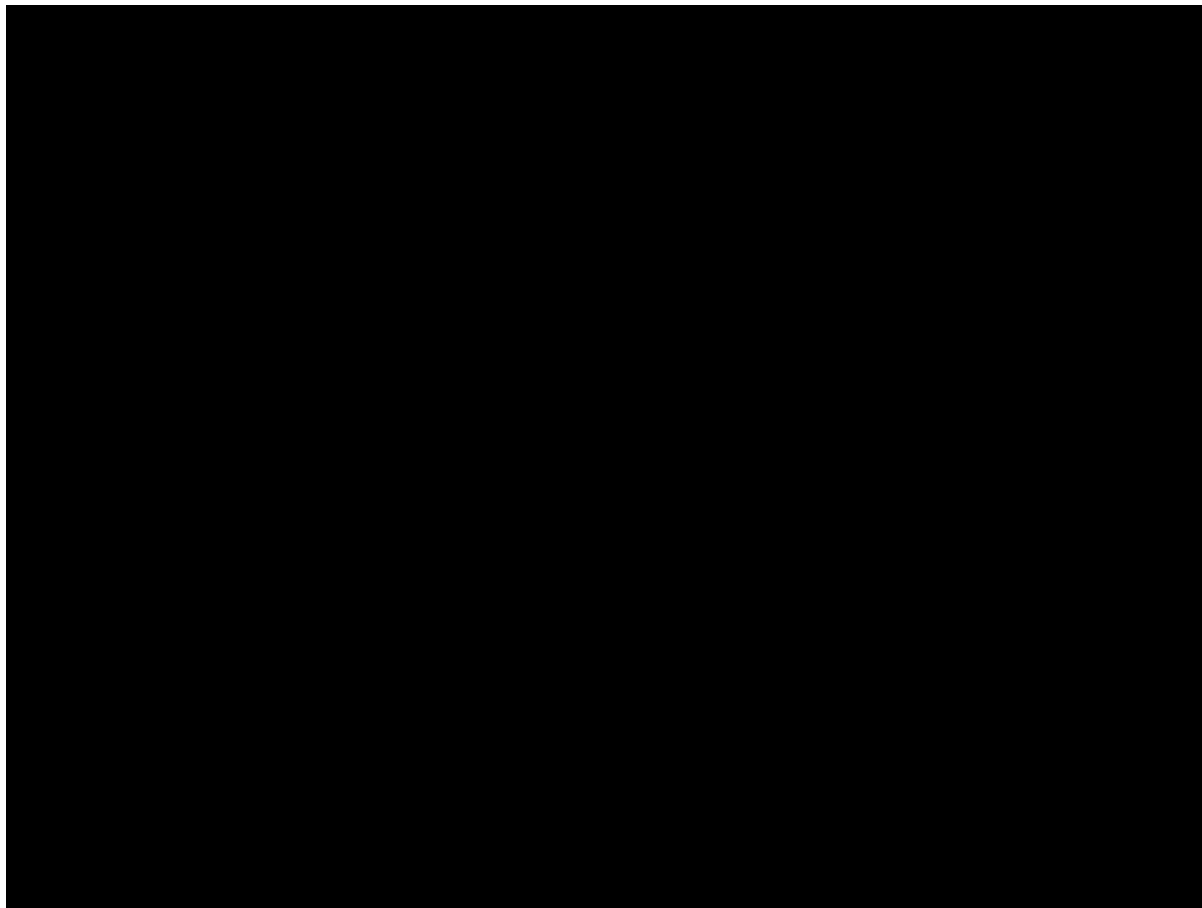
- 16 teachers, IT-support, nurse

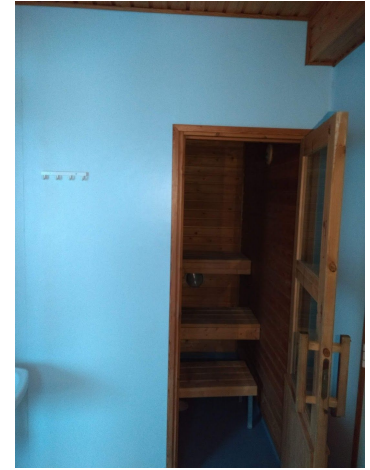
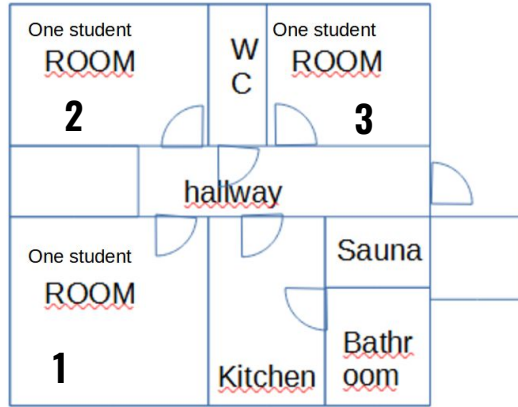

- Trips are mostly free for students, at least for now

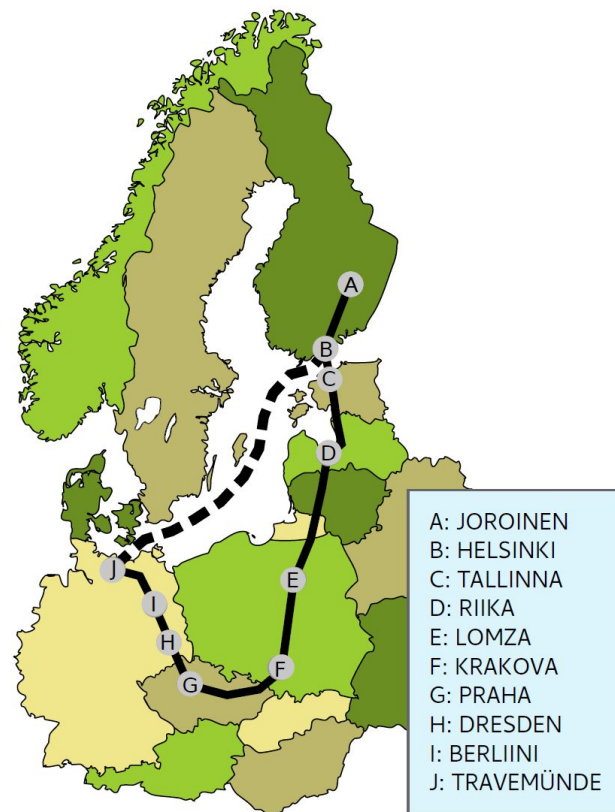
