For Non-EU students	<p>Check the Visa Info Sheets if you have a non-European nationality. The deadlines to apply for your visa/residence permit are:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 June 2017 for the Fall semester. - 1 November 2017 for the Spring semester <p>If you have any questions concerning your visa or residence permit, please contact our Central Student Administration, international department by sending an e-mail to: international@inholland.nl</p>
Accommodation	<p>We offer accommodation for exchange students. There is a limited number of rooms available, so please apply as soon as possible! The application for accommodation starts on:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - 1 May for the Fall semester - 1 November for the Spring semester <p>If you want to look for accommodation yourself, this is allowed but we do not recommend it. 95% of the exchange students live in the accommodation offered by Inholland. Student rooms are hard to find, since many of these student rooms are rented out for minimum a year and without furniture. Furthermore, if you want to look for accommodation yourself please be aware that it will cost you between 550-800 Euro for a room in a shared student house (so a lot more expensive!)</p> <p>To apply for the accommodation through Inholland please have a look at the website</p>
Insurance	<p>European students need to bring a European Health Insurance card. We highly recommend all students to take out a liability insurance as well. Non-European students need to take out an Insurance Passport for Students (IPS). In case Inholland applies for your Visa or Residence Permit, we will take out the IPS insurance on your behalf.</p>
