Student residence	The International Office offers support in finding accommodation. The <u>Studierendenwerk Thüringen</u> (student service) administers approximately 1100 apartments. The university does not have its own accommodation. Normally up to 5 students share living quarters. Students have single rooms, the kitchen and the bathroom are shared. Students from EU countries need to have an European Health Insurance Card issued by a health insurance company of their home country.

Requirements	Good skills in listening, reading, speaking and writing, if possible, at least at beginner and intermediate level (Zertifikat Deutsch als Fremdsprache). Exchange students need to prepare for their exchange semester with German lessons.
