The required proficiency levels are <b>A2 for the Bachelor's Students and B1 for the Master's Students</b>.</p> <p>To prove their language competences, the students will have to send a language certificate such as:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Official Italian language certificate</li> <li>- Erasmus+ Online Linguistic Support assessment result</li> <li>- Certificate of language proficiency issued by the sending institution</li> <li>- self-certification by the student</li> </ul>
