Accommodation:	<p>Our exchange students usually stay in one of our halls of residence. A room is guaranteed to all our exchange students for their entire period of stay if the application deadline is met. More information on how to apply can be found on our online application portal.</p> <p>Please keep in mind that you can move in the hall of residence before the start of the semester (i.e., if you participate in the introductory language course). You can start your rental contract either on the 1st or 15th day of each month. The prices for rooms (all with internet access) vary according to the duration of your stay. Please see our website for prices: www.uni-giessen.de/acc</p> <p>As an alternative you might like to check if there are free private rooms to let from outgoing students of JLU to incoming exchange students (on the same link as above).</p>

InfoTisch/Introduction Week:	<p>During our study introduction week (InfoTisch) our mentors will give you information concerning your studies in Giessen. They will help you with enrolment and inform you about all important dates which should not be missed.</p> <p>The InfoTisch usually starts two weeks before the start of lectures in the winter semester and one week before the start of lectures in the summer semester.</p> <p>Our mentors welcome you during that period every Monday, Wednesday and Friday morning. For more details please see your letter of acceptance which you will receive by regular mail or have a look at: www.uni-giessen.de/international-pages/study/ow/</p>
German Language Courses:	<p>We offer evening classes in German (free of charge) during the semester. Before each winter semester, you can attend our International Summer Course, before each summer semester our International Spring Course. Both courses include intensive German Language Courses, excursions, workshops, and much more.</p> <p>For the International Summer Course exchange students pay only a reduced fee of € 430.</p> <p>For the International Spring Course exchange students pay only a reduced fee of € 150.</p> <p>Please register online. Language Requirements:	<p>There are no general language requirements for exchange students. Some departments require proof of certain English or German language skills. We strongly recommend German language skills of at least B1 level to be able to follow classes and to communicate in everyday life!</p> <p>Please ask our exchange/departmental coordinators (see above) for required German language skills in advance!</p>
Average Living Expenses:	<p>Expect approx. € 680 per month (including accommodation, health insurance, subsistence, broadcasting fees) plus a (re)registration fee of around € 230,- for your student ID card which includes the "semesterticket" (free public transport within Hesse) and a contribution to the students' union in order to profit from cheaper prices in the student restaurants, halls of residence, etc. The (re)registration fee has to be paid at the beginning of each semester (see your letter of acceptance for details).</p>
